WHY "REGISTER" FOR WALK FOR LIFE?

Plus you are guaranteed goodie bag when you drop off your completed pledge form! HOW CAN I GET INVOLVED IN WALK FOR LIFE?

1. You can do everything online!

- a. Create your own fundraising page: givebutter.com/walk-for-life-2020
It's super easy and only takes a few minutes once you click "FUNDRAISE"
- b. Share your fundraising page link with your family, friends, and co-workers via text, email, or social media.
- c. No need to collect money! Donations can be made via Venmo, Paypal or Credit Card.
- d. If a sponsor hands you a cash or check, keep it in an envelope and bring it to the nearest center between June 19 - 22. We will enter it under your account. (please remember to add your name on the envelope).

2. You can still use a hard copy form.

- a. If sponsors wish to give you cash or checks, please mark the "cash" or "check" box below their name.

HOW DO I TURN IN COLLECTED PLEDGES?

DO I HAVE TO COLLECT THE MONEY?

You DO NOT have to collect the money, but if you do please collect into an envelope and drop of with your paper pledge.

WHAT HAPPENS ON SATURDAY, JUNE 20?

1. Wake up ready to walk and pray! Get those walking shoes on! Decide where you want to walk from: home, your favorite park, or a trail.
2. Join us on Facebook and on our givebutter fundraising page at 9:00 am as we connect virtually to watch our **Walk4Life** kick-off. This video will feature LPC CEO Carolyn Doyle, PRC CEO Jim Sprague, key leaders in the pro-life movement, and a few more surprises!
3. The online event will finish, and you can begin walking two miles (any time during the day on June 20). Along the way, take a break and stop. We will have a video for you to watch at three different stops (3 key stops here in the area). You will find those three videos on our website and on facebook. We ask you to imagine yourself at each prayer stop. Quiet your mind and heart and pray. Every half mile, stop and watch a short video at each prayer stop to unite us in prayer.
